## **Research Brief**



Title: Library On-Demand Survey Date: June 28, 2016

During the spring 2016 semester students using librarian services were asked to take a brief survey with regard to their needs.

There were 57 respondents. Students were asked to identify which course brought them in. Nearly half were there for help with English (42%) followed by Biology (16%), Political Science and Microbiology (9%), Art and Art History (5%), Communication, Food and Nutrition, History, Music, and PE (2% each). 4% did not indicate a course specifically.

Students were asking for help with research papers (65%), Peer-Reviewed Articles (11%), Essays (5%), Argument Assignments or Project (4%). Other items included family history, MLA formatting, citing work, periodic articles, and resource materials.

Overall, students had very positive responses and none disagreed or showed any level of dissatisfaction.

When asked their level of agreement with gaining increased confidence in conducting future research projects, students indicated 96%. Students also felt 100% comfortable asking the Librarians help in the future.
