Mr. Collier shared words of wisdom and songs of inspiration on February 16, in honor of African American Heritage Month.

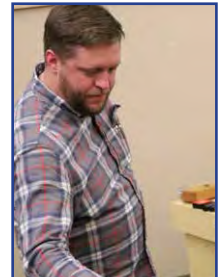

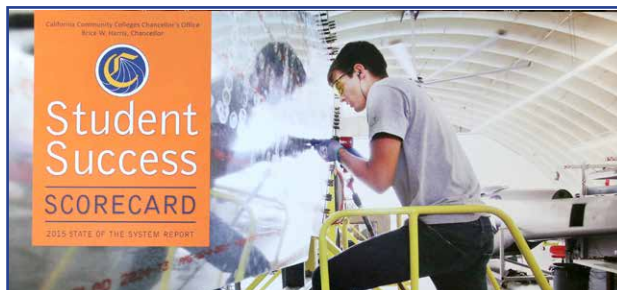
