To obtain the Associate in Arts in Communication Studies for Transfer Degree, students must complete the following requirements:

- 1. Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including both of the following:
 - a. The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State
 University General Education Breadth requirements.
 - b. A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.
- 2. Obtainment of a minimum grade point average of 2.0. Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs) also require that students must earn a "C" grade or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.

Notes:

- Certification of either the California State University General Education Breadth (CSU GE-Breadth)
 or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC-CSU version) is required.
 CSU GE- Breadth and IGETC advising sheets are available in Student Services, AC2-133 or online at
 CCC GE (CSU/UC) GE and Major Sheets
- Courses may double count in the major and CSU GE-Breadth or IGETC.
