- *** Veterans or Active Duty Reservist. Clovis Community College will grant course credit to a Veteran or Active Duty Reservist student who has completed basic military training verified by form DD-214 (Separation Document), Joint Services Transcripts, or other official forms submitted to the Veterans Counselor. The documentation must delineate completion of basic military training or credit earned in a military school.
- **** Digital Technology Literacy. Courses in digital technology literacy are those which examine the skills and ethics needed to become capable and responsible digital citizens. To satisfy the general education requirement in digital technology literacy, a course should help students develop an awareness of the five competencies associated with digital technology literacy, utilize multiple aspects of digital technology, and courses primary focus must be in working with computer technology.

To use information and communication technologies to:

- 2. Create solutions using digital technology.
- 3. Create digital content.
- 4. Communicate using digital content.
- 5. Examine ethical implications associated with technology usage.

These courses should develop an awareness of the skills needed to work and live in a culture that is increasingly becoming more technological. Students may petition for courses to count towards this requirement, if the course is not listed above.
