Dear President Ikeda:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting June 8-10, 2016, reviewed the Institutional Follow-Up Report submitted by Clovis Community College, evidentiary materials also submitted, and the Report prepared by the evaluation team that visited on April 4, 2016. College leadership, including the president of the Board of Trustees and the Interim Chancellor, certified the report. The purpose of the Commission's review was to determine whether the College had fully addressed the recommendations noted during the spring 2015 comprehensive review.

After considering all of the written material noted above, the Commission finds that Clovis Community College has addressed District Recommendations 7, 8, and 9 intended to increase institutional effectiveness and continues to meet Standards IV.B.3.c, IV.B.1.a-j, and IV.B.1.a. The Commission also took action to require the College to submit a **Follow-Up Report by October 15, 2016** demonstrating continued improvement with regard to Standards IV.B.1.a-j and IV.B.1.a from District Recommendations 8 and 9.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission requires that you give the Follow-Up Report, the External Evaluation Team Report, and this letter appropriate dissemination to your College staff and to those who were signatories of your Follow-Up Report. The Commission also requires that these documents be made available to students and the public by placing a copy on the College website. Please note that in response to public interest in accreditation, the Commission now requires institutions to post accreditation information on a page no more than one click from the institution's home page.

The Commission encourages the College's continued work to ensure educational quality and to support student success. Accreditation and peer review are most effective when institutions and the ACCJC work together to focus on student outcomes and continuous quality improvement in higher education. Thank you for sharing the values and the work of accreditation.
