CCC CLOVIS LAW SOCIETY HELD A CONSTITUTION DAY

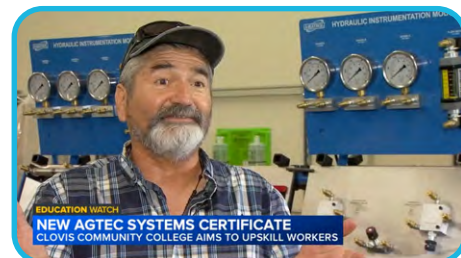

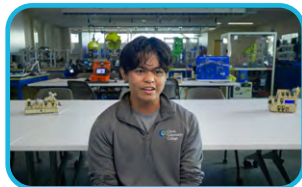
