- #5** in California for Perkins Economically Disadvantaged students' rate of transfer to a 4-year institution.

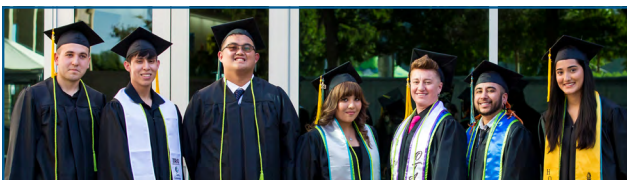

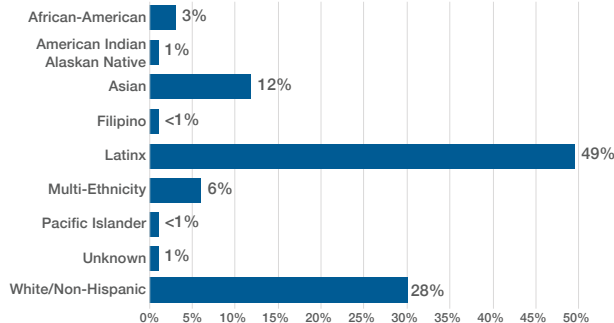

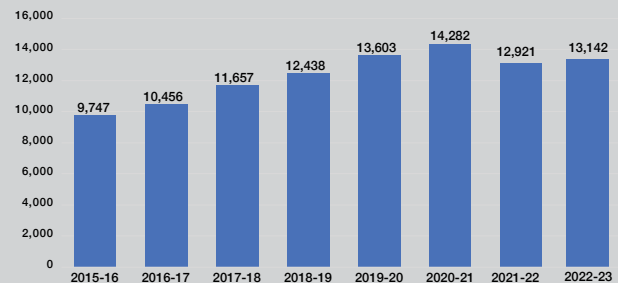

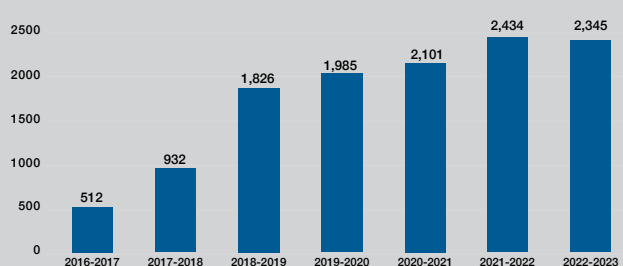

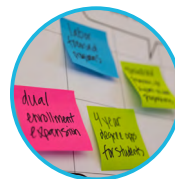
## VARIOUS EVENTS HELD ON CAMPUS
