Elementary Teacher Education Associate in Arts Degree for Transfer

Complete the following program of study. (Major # C.5892.AA-T) Major requirements (33 Units minimum).

The Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education: Integrated Programs for Transfer Degree is intended for students who plan to complete a bachelor's degree at a CSU campus. The Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer Degree aligns with a common core of lower division courses in Liberal Studies, which is the major used to pursue Elementary Teacher Education. Students who complete the Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer Degree are guaranteed admission to the CSU system, but not to a particular campus or major. Students transferring to a CSU campus that accepts the Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer Degree will be required to complete no more than 60 units after transfer to earn a bachelor's degree. The common core includes courses in science, math, arts and the humanities, which parallel the common core competencies for the elementary teacher credential known as the Multiple Subject Credential.

- Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University.
- Completion of Cal-GETC.
 - *Students who maintain catalog rights prior to Fall 2025 may use IGETC or CSU-GE Breadth.
- A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.
- Obtainment of a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- A grade of "C" or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.
