Complete the following program of study. (Major #C.5301.AA-T) Major requirements (18 units minimum). This is a transfer degree for English majors at Clovis Community College site students. Completion of this major allows students to transfer to CSU as a junior.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, a Bachelor's degree in English leads to employment in adult education, remedial education, literacy, and GED teaching. Other fields that employ English majors include counseling, editing, interpreting, translation, and K-12 teaching. A BA in English is also considered a rigorous, complementary education for careers in the legal profession including lawyers, paralegals, judges, and clerks.

- Completion of Cal-GETC.
 - *Students who maintain catalog rights prior to Fall 2025 may use IGETC or CSU-GE Breadth.
- A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.
- Obtainment of a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- A grade of "C" or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.
