To obtain the Associate in Arts in History for Transfer, students must complete the following requirements:

- Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University.
- Completion of Cal-GETC.
- **Students who maintain catalog rights prior to Fall 2025 may use IGETC or CSU-GE Breadth.*
- A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.
- Obtainment of a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- A grade of "C" or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis.

Notes:

- *ETHNST 32 is "same as" *HIST 32
- Certification of California General Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is required. Cal-GETC and major sheets are available in Student Services, AC2-133 or online at [CCC GE \(CSU/UC\) GE and Major Sheets](#)
- Courses may double count in the major and CSU GE-Breadth or IGETC.
