- Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units of degree-applicable courses,
- Minimum overall grade point average of 2.0,
- Minimum grade of “C” (or “P”) for each course in the major, and
- Completion of Cal-GETC
 - *Students who maintain catalog rights prior to Fall 2025 may use IGETC or CSU-GE Breadth.*
- Courses may double count in the major and Cal-GETC.
- Certification of California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is required.
